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Abstract

The topic of my research is An Anthropological Study of the Socio-Psychological Effects of Technology on Human Relationships. I have conducted this research because I have to analyze the generational perception of the people towards cellular technology to inquire that How far the people adopted the changing social set up with the usage of technology and also to know the Impact assessment of use of modern technology on social and political change and also to explore that How technology creates a sanitized image of our lives which creates social pressure to live that life style. I have used interview guide to receive data and information from my respondents. I also have my key informants who have helped me in gain data. I have conducted in depth interviews and focus group discussions with my respondents which I have selected by using purposive and accidental sampling. I have selected my respondents from different age groups and from different backgrounds in order to include diverse data in my research. I have found that technology is an essential for us and technology has great impact on our life. Secondly my respondents have told me that they have faced great social pressure and their relationship is affected by online communication. The young generation is quite comfortable in adopting the coming changes in the technology and they have a very positive attitude about the changing roles dynamics of the society because of technology but the elders are somehow reluctant in adopting technology in their lives.

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1 INTRODUCTION

“The use of the term "technology" has changed significantly over the last 200 years. Before the 20th century, the term was uncommon in English, and it was used either to refer to the description or study of the useful arts” (George Crabb 1823).

The definition of technology is science or knowledge put into practical use to solve problems or invent useful tools.

The technology domain is growing and flourishing through leaps and bounds. it has created an aura of connectedness and relatedness within the interpersonal relationship by using it to communicate with long distant relations. However it has also resulted in dissatisfaction within the human relationships on account of not conveying the full message that one wants in real. Some consider Technology to be the way to less demanding and quicker correspondence, while others see its adverse consequences for connections and relations.

Genuine form of communication is in form of face to face interaction that involves not only verbal but also nonverbal cues but technology has made social interaction more apt through the use of social networking sites which enables one to communication with one another in more convenient way than before. Social technology has enabled us to stay connected with our family and friends more often than the times when we have little access to technology and communication gadgets. However technology has replaced face to face interaction to an extent where screen to screen interaction has dominated.

As Przybylski and Weinstein of the University of Essex wrote, “Recent advancements in communication technology have enabled billions of people to connect more easily with people great distances away, yet little has been known about how the frequent presence of these devices in social settings influences face-to-face interactions” (Przybylski& Weinstein, 2012). However Families and friends across great distances can now more easily communicate face-to-face anytime they want.

It is given that digital technology (mobile phones, laptop etc.) degrades the quality of conversation as compared to face to face communication. The utilization of the internet has generously lessened the desire of adolescents for eye to eye communication with their family and acquaintances.(Elsobeihi.& Abu Naser, 2017).

There has been an increase in the number of communication technologies over the past decade therefore it is important to examine technologies impact on individual life and its effect on their relationship. There is a drastic increase in technology usage by the youth these days and so has an adverse effect on their relationship with the fellow colleagues and family members. The communication technologies including the cell phones, the Internet, and social networking sites such as facebook, twitter and instagram etc. have grown as a central feature in lives of individual as tools for establishing and maintaining relationships.

Social networking sites such a Twitter and Linked. It enable individual to seek out to professional people out there that enable him/her to explore their expertise and look out for more opportunities. Likewise Facebook enable people to maintain their relationship with their friends and family. However there has to be an equilibrium and limitation in online and offline communication as it can adversely affect our relation with others. Mobiles technology has made humans to be plugged in their cell phone most of the day, being disconnected from the world outside. Moreover Individuals are in a constant race of self-presentation, portraying themselves as leading ideals lives.

Even though technology has shortened long distance communication and has created a positive image in maintaining and strengthening familial relationships by being in contact with each other anytime. However some technological advances cause people to be unfocused, overly stressed, and being fell in the dungeon of self-isolation. There are cons to this invention as sometimes the quantity of people that interact with on social media exceeds the quality of people.

Technology has been so integrated into our lives that in some people it awakes anxiety for example when they are not in contact with their mobile phones. According to a research it was concluded that the more people use internet, the more it affected individuals communication with family members, also it lead to the decline in social circle and contact with people outside the virtual world and thorough usage of mobile technology and seeing other people profile lead to increases in their depression and loneliness. (Kraut et al.,1998).

In the book 'Reclaiming Conversation' it has been stated that there has been a decrease in empathy and creativity of individual due to the increasing reliance on gadgets. The way we have shifted to screen communication instead of face to face interaction has impacted our ability to respond and understand each other in real life. (Turkle, 2016). Communication technology has created a wave to bring people together and at the same time made people



isolated of one another. However it depends on the way one uses the technology to be either in the benefit of individual or against it. Sometimes it enables one to mask their life and embody it in a superficial way. Other times it is beneficial to create contact with outside world and acquire information about the ongoing circumstances at once just by sitting in one place and scrolling down the newsfeed.

If there's an internet-capable device with a screen anywhere nearby, the immediate world doesn't get our full attention. It got me thinking about the long term impact of technology on personal interactions.

Much has been written about the dangers of Internet addiction. From pornography to merely surfing the web, the Internet is clearly the television of the 21st century, an electronic drug that often yanks us away from the physical world. Like any addiction, the real cost, for those of us who are truly addicted, is to the number and quality of our relationships with others. We may enjoy online relationships using social media sites like Facebook or Twitter, for example, but the difference between these kinds of interactions and interactions with people in the physical world is clearly vast. As long as we expect no more from these online relationships than they can give, no good reason exists why we can't enjoy the power of social media sites to connect us efficiently to people we'd otherwise not touch. The problem, however, comes when we find ourselves subtly substituting *electronic* relationships for physical ones or mistaking our electronic relationships for physical ones. We may feel we are connecting effectively with others via the Internet, but too much electronic-relating paradoxically engenders a sense of social isolation.

Technology is often introduced into a social system with the stated intention of making life easier for people. As technology becomes more pervasive in everyday life, the assessment of technology's presence in relationships and its impact on how humans interact with one another is an emerging area of study. There are many perspectives on the relationship between technology and human interactions and relationships. It is purported that the integration of technologies in everyday life can have profound effects on human relationships, in both positive and negative ways. More notably, technologies impact on or interfere with how individuals engage in interpersonal relationships, behave within relationships, and project feelings and meanings including displays of emotions and love. Essentially, the new technological landscape now connects to what it means to be human.

Technology has changed the way in which we meet, interact, and stay in touch with one another. And I argue that what we crave hasn't caught up to these shifts, leaving us confused, dissatisfied, and having more misunderstandings than ever before.

Technology has both aspects positive or negative. Technology and human life cannot be separated. Society has a cyclical co dependence on technology. We use technology depend on technology on our daily life and our needs and our demands for technology keep on rising. Human use technology to travel to communicate to learn to do a business and to live in comfort. However technology has also caused us concerns. 2 LITERATURE REVIEW

Youth and parent attitudes towards social media also varied among different social groups. My study of family technology use showed that parenting social media echoes challenges of earlier technologies, but was also expected by new dynamics like mobility and pervasiveness. Parenting is a dynamic process and parents' strategies both shape and are shaped by social media. HCC research has largely focused on putting technology in people's hands to try to improve their lives in some way. (Yardi, July 27, 2012)

In these lines the author says that the youth perception and the parents perception about the social media is completely different and that depend upon the context and theme of such groups as social media and technology have given much importance in the era where living without technology is unbelievable, such technology like mobile ,computer and internet has given much more important the youth are usually in connection with them, so what are the reasons and things that make parents worried about technology that what would be the consequences of that on their children. So the parenting in context of social media is having different dynamics the people are in contact with technology they are having the focus as a Parents .Parents have also different view about the technology some of the parents are saying that it's just best for their child so they should be in contact with world and education requirements but some of the parents are having very different view as they think that social media is making their child bed in some way. As one of the report by HCC they said that if the technology reached in every ones hand that will change their lives in different context they will get benefits from the technology that will improve their lives and they will be aware of the use of technology.

Whether or not youth are actually digital experts is up for debate, but teens are often perceived as experts. The teen guru" is characterized as a source of technical help and advice that owes from teen to adult. For parents, there is a tension between their desire to have a child who develops expertise in computing and a child who uses the computer too much. This creates tensions in power and authority among parents and teens. (Yardi, July 27, 2012, p. 20)

In these lines the writers says that we are usually seen or listen that the youth are very sharp in context of using technology while that is mobile, software and anything which came in the

definition of technology they are the experts of it. But we often seen that the teen aged are much shaped in the use of technology they are very expert in using technology. The domestication of the social web into teens' everyday lives echoes the growing pains of every new media that has come before it. Some of these patterns mirror those of earlier generations; for others, existing routines give

way to new ones. In the 1960's, teens' communication through the home telephone disrupted family routines and rituals. For example, with the birth of the television, families had to make decisions about whether to incorporate television into the dinner time routine, in the same way they do with mobile phones now (and continue to do with television).

In these lines the author says that the social media has created such pains amounts youth in our societies by changing their theme and visions. They are as much addicted of social media without it they feel as they are in pain or in bed condition. There was time as in 1960 when social media was not that much in used in our society we think that it has makes our lives in different ways comfortable. For example, Sherry Turkle questions if we are becoming too emotionally attached to our devices and will lose our ability to maintain relationships with people (Turkle, 2011).

Why some are accepting and some are not accepting or some people are in some context accepting and in some not. The use of radio, television and internet are

(Krcmar, 18 Jul 2013)

In EHS programs, stimulating play interactions between mothers or fathers and their children predicted children's 5th grade math and reading abilities. (Understanding Family Engagement Outcomes)

More recent studies have placed emphasis on social networking sites and their relationship with self-esteem and wellbeing. In a Dutch study involving 881 young people, it was found that positive feedback on the young person's profile on the CU2 (See You Too) social networking site enhanced self-esteem and well-being and negative feedback decreased their self-esteem and well-being. (Deborah Richards, 2015)

Children Adult studies have linked self-esteem to social media use, and it is likely that this is also true with children with potentially more significant health effects. This literature review seeks to alert care givers to the potential benefits and dangers of social media networking by children and young adults and urge researchers to improve theoretical understanding in this field, raise societal awareness and offer practical guidance to those in positions of responsibility including health practitioners, parents and site developers. (Deborah Richards, 2015)

In these lines the author says that the currently education system we are usually connected with the social media for getting the education materials that will help us in our studies and course. By using or making the students used of the social media the students health will also effect in different context. Social media is here to stay and increasingly being used by children and young people. Although social media can have a positive impact on the health and well-being of children and young people, it can also pose risks for these vulnerable populations. These risks can be minimized by appropriate website design, identification of those most at risk and development of strategies to help them manage these risks. Some of the social media risks for children can be minimized by adding in safety features; however, that is unlikely to happen in social media sites that are also used by adults because of the restrictive nature of these controls. (Deborah Richards, 2015)

In these lines, the author sets that social media is used now a day more by the child and the young generation of the societies and this usage is increasing more and more with daily reports. Although as we discuss it earlier that it is having much impact on the health of an adult as when a young man or a child all the day will be busy on the social media, he will not eat his diet, will be damaged, he will not walk as an usually individual should do, his health will be damaged, when he will use it usually his attention towards the family will be limited and he will not be that much in attraction with his family so his social interaction with family will be damaged through the usage of the social media. If we want to resolve it, we should make such plans of the web sites that how such web should be appropriate and will benefit from it, the people will have their limit that they should use a site in this limit and that aged or limited person should be having access of the that particular site. Some of the sites are having this option for child that they are not allowed until their age limited should be that much but that cannot be seen as the proper situation to do that. The adult should be having their limits to access a site which can damage their ability of thinking and they can't be damaged through it.

Young people report that they prefer to take responsibility for their own health decisions and are generally comfortable with assessing the quality and accuracy of health information found online. However, their interpretation and application of the information is also likely to be influenced by the same

social media forums. Aspects of online health information that appealed to young people include removing the need to disclose confidential information to the health-care provider, convenience and time saving and reduced associated costs. (Deborah Richards, 2015)

In these lines the author says that the health problems which came through the usage of the social media on the health of young adult and children of the society, they are having this answer that they find the solution of the problem on net while that problem is regarding health and any other social problem, they find the answer of that problems online they think by doing such that activities they will be overcome on that, for example if a person is becoming fat just because of sitting all the time in front of his laptop, computer and mobile and he feels that it is problem and he should overcome that problem he will search on net and will find the ways how to overcome that, instead of that if a person gives some times to the social media and gone every day for walking that problem will automatically solve but thinking on that they will always focusing that to find the solution on that place which is unbelievable. Huesmann (2003) opined that media violence produces long term effect via severat type of learning process leading to the acquisition of last aggressive scripts international schemas, and aggression supporting beliefs about social behavior and by reducing normal negative emotional responses to violence.

This is to say that, research in violent films and television and music reveals unequivocal evidence that media violence increases the likelihood of aggression and violent behavior in both immediate and long time context.

Sefton (1995) opined the nature of the contemporary social change, precisely because they both embody similar technological assumptions about growth, progression and development which underpin the modern society.

New technologies which for the purpose of this volume are primarily defined as a digital information and communication media such as computer and internet are also described in the term of binary opposition.

This, they are fragmenting contemporary society; yet using they are transferring culture and communication or merely conferring privilege on a few. Young people are utilizing and appropriating arrange of new technologies in the making of youth culture in the digital age.

Prensky (1990) pointed out that since the internet and other media have been adopted and integrated into daily lives of an increasing number of young adolescents, and word view of younger generation. Controversies about whether the media and technology shapes values, attitudes and social behaviors are not in new.

The rapid expansion of media stimulated similar discussion of its cultural and social effects. The technological deterministic view presents the internet is an innovative force that has profound influence on youth.

Russel (2007) said that conception of adolescence particularly the messages and representation of what constitute girlhood are deeply entrenched social, technological and overly curtly moves, evident in the changing faces of the young and popular culture.

New social media is an important part of our lives because it promotes the interconnectedness and interdependence of our culturally diverse world. Media for social interaction allows for people to communicate and engage with information that is quickly accessible on the Internet. Cultural differences influence communication, behavior, and values. In relation to new social media, differences in individualistic and collectivistic cultures are apparent in users' communication and behavioral styles. The Diffusion of Innovation Theory (DOI) explains how advancements and new ideas spread within a social organization. Four popular types of social media and networking sites are Face book, YouTube, Twitter, and the phone. An example of social media that promotes the exchange of messages between people across the world is Face book. (Sawyer, 2011).

“Ever since they began to practice this perverse excess of printing books, the church has been greatly damaged,” lamented Francisco Penna, a Dominican defender of the Spanish Inquisition. Similar concerns have also been raised in the aftermath of the ascendancy of the electronic media—television in particular has been often represented as a corrosive influence on public life. Plato’s reservation about the influence of new media on culture continues to influence the current deliberation on the influence of the Internet and of social media. The Internet serves as metaphor through which wider social and cultural anxieties are communicated. That is why for so many of its critics its impact on offline culture appears in such a negative light. (Furedi, How the Internet and social media are changing culture)

Friends and family seem to call each other less and less and communicate via social media from the same house and sometimes the same room! This is not a good thing! It’s a strange culture we now live in when we call everyone for dinner via text message. (Culture, 2011)

Social networks started as a place to connect with your friends in an easy and convenient way. Truly speaking, many of you might have found your old pals from school or college who were out of touch due to one reason or other, well I would say I have and I thank social networks for this. Social networks has provided us the opportunity to connect with people and build better relationships with friends with whom we are unable to meet personally, and let them know about our life and take input about their lives and events happening with them. (Ali, 2012)

With social networks we are able to communicate our thoughts and perceptions over different topics with a large number of audiences, and raise our voice. The sharing feature available on the social networks makes your opinion about any topic reach huge number of people (even to those who are not on your friends list). We have the option to make groups with people who are like minded and share the related news with them and ask for their opinion or input about the topic. Simply there are a number of options available for us to communicate with others on these social networks. (Ali, 2012)

There are sure to be many political changes that come about due to social media. There are now proposals for internet voting, which could lead to more people participating in elections. This could make social media even more influential, as people could literally vote moments after reading the latest comments or links they found on Face book or Twitter. Other advancements will also change politics. Polling techniques on social media will become more common and, hopefully, more accurate. More virtual political rallies and town halls will take place. (Satterfield, 2016)

How do social media affect interaction in our society? Will face-to-face communication ultimately diminish because of these new social technologies? These questions are ones that many researchers have found extremely intriguing since the advent and popularization of social media in the last decade. Within this topic, social competency is an important ideal that most people strive towards, but there is evidence to support the claims that social media is actually harming people's ability to interact competently in an offline setting. (HaleyJones, 2013)

The use of media has an impact on social relationships, social well-being and time available for sleep, school related study and other activities. It was associated with more intense feelings toward online friends than in-person friends. The level of face-to-face communication was strongly negatively associated with media multitasking. These results suggest "that the growth of media multitasking should be viewed with some concern" .Conversely; face-to-face communication was strongly associated with a wide range of positive social feelings. (Slovenia, 2014)

2.1 Theoretical framework

The theoretical framework is a structure that can hold or support theory of a research study. The theoretical framework introduces and describes the theory that explains why the research problem under study exists.

I decided and mention the two theories which are revolving around my research that is the Modernization theory and the other is Rogers's theory of innovation.

2.1.1 Modernization Theory

Modernization theory is used to explain the process of modernization within societies. Modernization refers to a model of a progressive transition from a 'pre-modern' or 'traditional' to a 'modern' society. Modernization theory originated from the ideas of German sociologist Max Weber (1864–1920), which provided the basis for the modernization paradigm developed by Harvard sociologist Talcott Parsons (1902–1979). The theory looks at the internal factors of a country while assuming that with assistance, "traditional" countries can be brought to development in the same manner more developed countries have been. Modernization theory was a dominant paradigm in the social sciences in the 1950s and 1960s, and then went into a deep eclipse. It made a comeback after 1990 but remains a controversial model.

According to this theory of modernization pass through this period, pre modern to modern society. The culture values are less important for their citizens. The people of society have high living standards. These societies become complex because their structure changes. Their people become more mobile. The societies produce educated youth. Their youth have approach to the technology. They use technology to raise the society. Then these societies move to progression. These societies also exchange their goods and services.

New technology is a major source of social change. Since modernization entails the social transformation from agrarian societies to industrial ones, it is important to look at the technological viewpoint; however, new technologies do not change societies by it. Rather, it is the response to technology that causes change. Frequently, technology is recognized but not put to use for a very long time such as the ability to extract metal from rock. Although that initially went unused, it later had profound implications for the developmental course of societies. Technology makes it possible for a more innovated society and broad social change. That dramatic change through the centuries that has evolved socially, industrially,

and economically, can be summed up by the term modernization. Cell phones, for example, have changed the lives of millions throughout the world. That is especially true in Africa and other parts of the Middle East, where there is a low cost communication infrastructure. With cell phone technology, widely dispersed populations are connected, which facilitates business-to-business communication and provides internet access to remote areas, with a consequential rise in literacy.

2.2 Roger's Theory of Innovation

Rogers theory of innovation was developed by Everett Rogers in 1962, Rogers theory of innovation is also called theory of diffusion of innovation. This theory explains how a newly introduced technology accepted and adopted by the people and then how it become successful. It also describes how an old technology is modernized. It also explain how new technology spreads all over the world. Rogers's book "diffusion of innovation" shows that there are four elements for the circulation of new ideas in the innovations, communications channels time and social system. Technological innovations comprises of different stages.

Innovations circulate by the help of five steps:

1. **Knowledge:** first stage is to know how about technology by the people.
2. **Persuasion:** in this stage people start liking that technology. People want to get more information about this technology.
3. **Decision:** it is a complicated stage where people are confused. They have the choice to adopt it or reject it, because people know about the benefits and harm of technology. After this they decide to adopt that technology.
4. **Implementation:** then people start using that technology and get more knowledge about this technology.
5. **Confirmation:** it is the last stage in which people take decision to continue this technology or not.

The highly educated people are the one who bring revolution in a society. Such people gain knowledge about specific technology and adopt it. Then they consider whether they have to accept that technology or reject it. When educated people start adopting a technology, other people becomes imposed accept that technology with all its upcoming change. Before introducing the new technology, the educated people make cost benefit analysis sometimes

the technological innovation does not succeed because the cultural norms and values of the particular society in which innovation has take place, do not permit it.

One of my interviewee told me that the technology has changed the lives of at most everyone in the world who lives in this earth. Somehow somewhere it has an social pressure to everyone for example if someone wants to upload status on FB, WhatsApp and on Instagram first they think that, Is this status meaningful? What would be the impact of people when they look to it? All those type of things create some pressure on everyone now a days. According to him technology harms teen's mental health. Especially social media users are three time more likely to be depressed then others. A lot of usage of technology usage may negatively influence important aspects of physical health, which in result turns mental health. Respondent said that the technology has brought us closer to the reality of conflict.

The more advanced the world becomes technologically; the more persons begin to depend on computer machine and other forms of technology for everyday. It means that when a computer crashes, people become almost disabled until the problem is resolved. This kind of dependency on technology puts people at a distinct disadvantage, because they become less self-reliant. This is also some kind of social pressure that people are totally dependent on machines. According to respondent the main example of social pressure is that after sending message by someone to their loved one and waiting for their replies impact bad and poor pressure on sender. Social pressure includes: Waiting for emails, waiting for notifications from someone special, waiting for battery percentage and all such type of examples.

Social pressure often causes people to change their image of reality, and those who resist it are emotionally upset. Fitting in feels good, even at the expense of your otherwise good sense(s).

Social pressure on children like they are waiting for update of games, now mission unlocked which make them mentally anger.

3 METHODOLOGY

Essentially strategy is the mix of tools and systems techniques for information gathering. So, in this exploration, I have utilized diverse procedures and strategies with a specific end goal to get subjective data. For data collection I have selected following techniques. Anthropological methodology is different its perspective and had a wide range of application. This is an ethnography based research it is also a qualitative research and it is based on participation, interviews of different types, and for scientific research I have used a number of different procedures and approaches for observing the relevant phenomena. These approaches are different from each other based on various kinds and concepts employed in them. The conceptual tools analysis can be operational in host manners involving different procedure. The same applies to anthropological research.

3.1 Research Methodology

Methodology is combination of tools and techniques which researcher used for data collection. I also used some techniques and tools for my data collection to my research topic.

These are following.

3.2 Rapport Building

Rapport building is first step in research, that's why that was my first step in field. I spend five days for rapport building, in these days I was mated with different peoples on daily basis to talk with them on any topic, gossip with them, finally I wins trust of them. Then tell about my topic and select some persons who are giving me information about my topic.

3.3 Key Informants

Key informants prove to be a valuable source of data. They must be chosen with care, as they should be from the community being studied and are required to have a significant amount of knowledge about the people of any particular place. Key informants are those individuals of the community under study who provide the investigation with detailed knowledge and information. I selected two key informants for my research. One of my key informants is NaziaRafique a PhD scholar, another key informant of mine is Wajidrahim a student from Arid University.

According to Bernard,

"Good informants are people, who talks easily, understand the information you need, and who are glad to give you or get it from you"
(1994)

3.4 Participant Observation

Participant observation is a tool by which researcher carefully watch and note every events and situation in field. I also use this tool to collect my data. I personally participate and talk with the people and observe what things they discuss then at my home i note in my diary. And I didn't feel that I'm stranger here or the people around me I meet first time all the individual who cooperate with me are outstanding and made my research more useful to me.

3.5 Sampling

Sampling techniques was used by me in filed because there is vast population. My sample size was twenty five, from these I almost take all information about my topic. Basically I choose my sample from our youth a university going students or any individual who is using technology more and more for this purpose I visited university which is located on my locale where I conduct my research.. The basic idea behind sampling is the analysis of some of the elements in a population which provided useful information on the entire population. The sample is chosen by means of non-probability sampling. There were different sampling techniques, but I used two sampling techniques. One is purposive sampling and other is snow ball sampling.

3.5.1 Sample Size

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3.5.2 Accidental Sampling

“A convenience sample is a type of non-probability sampling method where the sample is taken from a group of people easy to contact or to reach. For example, standing at a mall or a grocery store and asking people to answer questions would be an example of a convenience sample. This type of sampling is also known as grabbed sampling or availability sampling. There are no other criteria to the sampling method except that people be available and willing to participate. In addition, this type of sampling method does not require that a simple random sample is generated, since the only criteria are whether the participants agree to participate.” (Lewis and Thornhil, 2012)

3.5.3 Purposive Sampling

“In this technique the researchers purposely choose subjects who, in their opinion, are relevant to the project. The choice of respondents is guided by the judgment of the investigator. For this reason, it is also known as judgmental sampling. There are no particular procedures involved in the actual choice of subjects.”

“In such cases the important criterion of choice is the knowledge and expertise of the respondents, and hence their suitability for the study.”

3.6 Fields Notes

Field notes are the notes or readings that are noted for making thesis writing easier. I transcribed interviews on my field notes and I wrote interviews, result of questionnaires and main items of my daily dairy on my field notes.

3.7 Interview

Interviewing is one of the method research techniques. It can be done in different ways, but indepth interviews is the best of all. Along with that, focus group discussion is also a kind of interview To get inside of someone thinking thoughts and explanations is interviewing not only to know what one sees but hidden. It is the discussion between the researcher and respondent to have specific objectives. Interview is a conversation with a purpose to get information. There are two types of interviews; structured and unstructured. Structured interviews are those that have been formulated in a pattern whereas unstructured are those that are based on a set plan however, do not have a regular patterns. I used both types of interviews structured and unstructured. I interviewed through interview guide which helped me to get the basic information related my topic. During interview most of the questions which is not written in my interview guide I ask from my respondent and that information is

very useful to my research. In depth interview is a useful research tool in anthropology for the collection of data.

3.8 In-depth Interviews

In-depth Interview provides qualitative data to an investigator. Interviewing the respondent is a major key to collect data and required information about the issue relating to the research topic. The most important method of in-depth interviews is also used during the research study of the selected persons, who provided a lot about the issue that were asked. In-depth interviews will conduct on different topic with different people directly or indirectly related to the research topic. The use of this important research tool, it is very easy to extract information from the interviewer by asking to the point question.

This technique is one of the leading sources of data in my research. First the researcher took due appointments from this respondent and interviewed them separately. Usually Researcher had three to four discussions with one person. In these interviews, asked those questions keeping in view my research objectives. The researcher recorded the interviews as per their will. Sometimes the researcher noted down things on the spot, but in most of the cases, the researcher tried to avoid paper and pen to make my respondents as comfortable as possible.

3.9 Audio Recording

The audio recording is included to verify and cross checked the collected information through jotting and in depth interview guide. This tool is helpful in an ethnographic data collection, which is the essence of anthropological research, because during taking interviews it is not possible to note each and every point of respondent that is why I have used voice recording during interviews. Such recordings were helpful during thesis writing because when you are in the process of writing dissertation concepts may overlap or missed from a thematic understanding of the topic.

3.10 Daily Diary

Writing a diary is simple and effective in which one records the experiences and facts daily find in the field, it's a memorandum in quite helpful when analyzing after the field. It has the daily records, time and important events relevant to the field.

“A daily diary is personal you absolutely need in the field. It will help to deal with loneliness, fear and other emotions that make field work difficult. It gives you an outlet for writing

things that you don't want to become part of public record". Daily diary will very helpful for me in remembering my past experiences.



4 AREA PROFIL

4.1 4.1. Introduction

This chapter deals with the area where I conducted my research. The research was conducted in Rawalpindi. This chapter helps to understand the culture, history, population and analyse the social position of the local. The reason why I choose this place is that there has not been any Anthropological research on the impacts of technology on human relations.

4.2 Rawalpindi

The active town of metropolis encompasses a ton a lot of to supply than a traffic mess, broken roads and haze-filled atmosphere. The city's history spreads over many millennia. Archaeologists believe that a definite culture flourished on this upland even three,000 years ago.

The archeological remains found here prove the existence of a Buddhist community up to date to Taxila, however less celebrated than its neighbour.

Historians believe that the traditional town fell victim to the devastation caused by the Huns. the primary Muslim interloper, Mahmud of Ghazni (979-1030AD), talented the ruined town to a Gakkhar chief, Kai Gohar. The Gakkhars were a fiercely freelance tribe of the Potowar upland. The town, however, being within the route of invaders, couldn't prosper and remained deserted till Jhanda Khan, another Gakkhar chief, renovated it and named it metropolis when the village Rawal in 1493.

Rawalpindi remained below the rule of the Gakkhars until Muqarrab Khan, the last Gakkhar ruler, was defeated by the Sikhs in 1765. The Sikhs invited traders from alternative places to settle here, that brought the town into the limelight.

Following a people finish over the Sikhs and occupation of metropolis in 1849, the town became a permanent garrison of a people army in 1851. within the Eighteen Eighties, a railway line to metropolis was set, and a train service started on January one, 1886. the necessity for a railway link arose when Lord Dalhousie created metropolis the headquarters of the Northern Command and therefore the town became the most important military garrison in British Republic of India.

In 1951, metropolis saw the murder of the primary electoral prime minister of Asian country, Liaquat Ali Khan, in Company Bagh, later named when him. Today, metropolis is that the headquarters of the Pakistan PakistanIslamic Republic of Asian country West PakistanAsian country Asian nation} Army and therefore the Pakistan Air Force.

The modern town has everything that one will need – sensible eateries, playgrounds and looking centres.

Though several looking centres have opened everywhere the town, 2 main bazaars, Raja Bazaar within the previous town and Saddar, that developed because the bivouac bazaar between the previous town and therefore the Mall, still attract an oversized range of tourists each day.



4.3 Language

Language is a fixed of symbols getting used in particular for conversation. The symbols may be spoken or written. Language is a component of human conduct. In written shape its miles a protracted-time period record of know-how from one era to the following at the same time as in spoken form it is a method of communicqué. Language is the key thing of human intelligence. People used to speak different languages. In my research area people belong to different areas and speak different languages. Common languages are;

Almost all people of my research area understand and speak Urdu language. People who belong to Murree speak Pothowari, and people who belong to the province of Punjab speak Punjabi. Pathan living in this area speak Pushto. People who belong to northern areas speak Shina. Urdu is the only language that has resemblance with all other languages, thus people use Urdu as medium of instruction for communication in public.

4.4 Religion

Islam is the religion followed by most of the people. Minority of the people follow other religions for example Christianity. Many people have different beliefs regarding Islam some call themselves Sunni and some call themselves Shia. Sunni also have many sub sects like Barelvi and Ehl-e-Hades.

4.5 Ethnic Groups

There are many ethnic groups. People have migrated from different areas. Pathans migrated from Peshawar. Many people migrated from northern areas and Punjabi living here migrated from Punjab province. An ethnic group is a collectively inside a bigger population having actual or putative not unusual ancestry, recollections of a shared beyond, and a cultural recognition upon one or greater symbolic factors which outline the institution's identification, such as kinship, faith, language, shared territory, nationality or physical appearance. Participants of an ethnic organization are aware of belonging to an ethnic organization.

4.6 Culture

Culture is a complex whole which includes knowledge, belief, art, law and custom of the people of any society. People in my locale follow culture of areas where they belong from. People give high priority to their cultural values. Azan is called in ears of child on its birth. Family system is normally followed by people. Nikkah is religious event to bind two people. Food is given for three days by relatives on death of any person.

4.7 Ceremonies

Ceremonies are important for people to share love, care and respect. Eid, wedding, anniversaries, are some ceremonies. People share their happiness and problems with their relatives and take suggestion to solve it. In this way they promote love in society.

Eidmiladudnabi and ashura are also celebrated here in Rawalpindi. Along with these festivities shab e barat, basant, shab e qadar are also celebrated.

4.8 Birth

In birth ceremonies, mostly all family, relatives and friends get together to celebrate the birth of the child. Mostly the male child is preferred and any female who gives birth to a son is more respected. The relatives and friends give gifts to the new born child and money, along with that the elder of the family gives the child the first food also known as Gutti (sweet things) in local language. It is said that the child develops the characteristics of the person who gives him his first food and hence the elders of the family, mostly the grandparents, find it their right to do so.

4.9 Food

People in Rawalpindi eat different kinds of food. They usually eat roti made of wheat flour and rice is also eaten by them. vegetables and pulses are also used by people of Rawalpindi. A vast variety of fruits is also available in markets in Rawalpindi..

4.10 Dress Pattern

Usually young teen aged boys wear jeans and casual shirts and old men wear shalwar and kameez. Females also wear shalwar and kameez and certain women who belong to elite class also wear western dresses. Dress patterns also vary from age group to age group and from one's personal likes and dislikes. Male members on Friday mostly wear shalwarkameez.

4.11 Basic Facilities of Life

Rawalpindi is a town that is attached to Islamabad and Murree. This area has established a lot. In that area water is also available. Government also provided Sui Gas. In that area taxi are also available for the people to travel from one place to other.

In the locale there are many other facilities, they are following

4.12 Mosque

There are some small mosques in Rawalpindi, where people practice prayers five times a day. People send their children's to mosque to get Islamic knowledge such as Namaz and Quran. People belong to two sects of religion that is Shia and Sunni. They have different mosques.

4.13 Game

There is no perfect playground but small grounds where small children's used to play different games such as Pithoun Garram (potsherd), cricket, and chrichikka (bad Minton). Children's also play in their streets. Kite flying is liked by children's as well as youngsters. Boys in Rawalpindi also play cricket as there are certain small ground for cricket. There are also gymnasiums in Rawalpindi. Male members of Rawalpindi go there for physical fitness. There are also gymnasiums for women where they can also go to keep them fit and healthy.

4.15 Household Pattern:

There are different types of houses in my locale. Majority of the houses are made up of cement and concrete. Some houses are made up of mud and cement. Also people have pets such as parrots, hen's. they keep happy with them.

4.16 Flora and Fauna

4.17 Castes

Other castes also includesmaliks, rajpoots, janjuas, yusufzai. There are also syeds living in Rawalpindi. Syeds are given massive respect in Rawalpindi and in almost in every muslim society as muslims attach religious values with them.

4.18 Climate

climate is described as a place's long-time period climate styles. The handiest way to describe climate is to examine common temperature and precipitation over time. Different beneficial factors for describing weather consist of the sort and the timing of precipitation, amount of light, common wind speeds and guidelines, range of days above freezing, weather extremes, and neighbourhood geography.

The climatic conditions of Rawalpindi are very favorable and mostly it's not as hotter as it should be because it is near murree which is a very hilly area and also there are margalla hills. So temperature or we can say that the climate of Rawalpindi is very enjoyable. In summer during the months of June, July, and august there is hot weather.

In short, climate is the outline of the lengthy-term sample of weather in a selected region. a few scientists define weather because the average weather for a specific vicinity and time period, normally taken over 30-years. It's in reality a median pattern of climate for specific vicinity. while scientists speak about climate, they are searching at averages of precipitation, temperature, humidity, sunshine, wind pace, phenomena including fog, frost, and hail storms, and different measures of the weather that arise over a protracted length in a selected area. as an instance, after searching at rain gauge data, lake and reservoir degrees, and satellite TV for pc records, scientists can tell if for the duration of a summer season, an area was drier than common. If it is still drier than everyday over the direction of many summers, than it might probably indicate a trade within the climate.

4.19 Occupations

There are different occupations of people in Rawalpindi. As Rawalpindi is very close to the federal capital Islamabad of Pakistan so people from all over the country come here in search of means of livelihood. Some people are doing government jobs while some are doing jobs in private organizations. There are also native people who do not do any kind of job as they have land in saddar and they generate sufficient income for themselves and they do not need to do private jobs.

There are also private businesses of people in Rawalpindi even outsiders come here from all over Pakistan and they are running their businesses. There are also cobblers, hair dressers and other manual labors are also found here in Rawalpindi. There are also motor mechanic shops

where mechanics are earning income by doing repairing of cars and motor bikes. Local shops are also here in Rawalpindi so we can say that we find small enterprises.

4.20 Division And Role of Gender

Arrangements for gender socialization start even before the beginning of the kid. One of the first questions humans ask of expectant mother and father is the intercourse of the child. that is the start of a social categorization manner that maintains during lifestyles. Usually there is patriarchy in Rawalpindi that is to say that male members are the head of families. And men go out to earn livelihood and women stay at home to take care of children. Although there are working women in Rawalpindi but their ratio is low as compared to non-working women.

4.21 Political Participation

People in Rawalpindi are highly politically active. Mostly native people support one party and the outsiders have different political affiliations. People usually cast their votes on different basis. These bases include peer group influence, family pressure and others. Women participation in politics is low as compared to men and even mostly women do not cast their votes by their own free will rather they are influenced by their male family members. Women's political participation and protection of ladies' rights has constantly been a task within the growing countries. Notwithstanding the truth that Pakistan is a developing united states with a developing economic system but girls have actively been trying to take part in government, and improvement of woman-oriented civil society.

5 GENERATIONAL PERCEPTION OF THE PEOPLE TOWARDS CELLULAR TECHNOLOGY

5.1 Perception

My first objective of my research is that, how people perceive the term technology and what's the opinion they have about the technology. All my respondents told me that technology is an essential for us and in now a day's technology has great impact on our life. My five respondents told me that technology is very essential. But it is essential, when we aware for the uses of this technology and social media also. How we use that particular technology either it is our mobile phones or any application by which we interrelated with each other. Respondents give both negative and positive perception about technology negative effects include a need for instant gratification, loss of patience.

My another respondent told me that most of his time he use social media and engage in these social applications most of the peoples spent most of their energy on these technology tools for being entertained, and being distracted away from deep engagement with people.

Another use full knowledge given by my respondent, told me that by this technology we are isolated ourselves on just to using mobile phones and on internet , we don't know that what's going inside our homes and we do not have enough time for our parents and our siblings from this I think technology is isolated when I ask question to my respondent that how do you define the term technology almost all the answers are same which I mentioned here in a paragraph, Technology affects everyone! Whether positive or negative, we are all affected, how it manifests itself into problems for youth will be studied and debated for years. Balancing technology throughout the educational process and keeping with current trends and uses of technology will affect everyone. Technology has transformed our youth's daily and social lives. How do we measure the effects of technology on our ability to socialize or have a successful social life? Socializing is not just talking face to face, it's our ability to interact, learn, and create original Technology hindering today's youth and their ability to socialize is affecting their capacity to read, write, and communicate. Today's youth depends on careful considerations for the implementation of technologies. Our youth do not have the capability to convey their emotions through the use of technology, understand sadness, happiness or joy through simple text or emails. Communicating through the use of text, chat, and social network sites is lost using abbreviations and slang, inhibiting the use of the

Standard English language. Using computers and hand held devices for relationships, reading, writing, and entertainment, turning them into introverted and socially inept individuals. Current trends resonating from our educational institutions to our workplace can be examples of how technology has altered the way younger people communicate. This tragedy transcends from youth to adulthood affecting the workplace. Social networking sites have begun to take hours away from employers. How do understand ethical and moral dilemmas unless they are allowed to make mistakes and work through a particular problem?

The current generation of children is completely different from the preceding ones. They are living in the digital age. Can you imagine how things were 20 years ago. How we communicate and exchange information with one another. Some things then may not be that accessible to us now, but in this day and age, everything is almost made possible by the advance communications technology surrounding us. Whether it's printed, audio or visual materials, all are now within our reach, especially because global trading is made available to almost all over the world.

Another perception by my respondent is, she told me that I think technology has changed society in both positive and negative ways. Technology has made access to education, communication, medicine; transportation very easy. Technology has brought the world closer, with the internet. It has saved many lives. However, using it too often has its drawbacks as well. We talk about the Internet as an information resource and a communication platform but we ignore the fact that an overexposure to it leads to Internet addiction. Many people do not realize that how Internet has changed their lives in a worse manner. Technology has changed the relationships of families. Distracted by their laptops, TV's, smart phones, and video games, families can't have a friendly attitude towards each other as they used to in the past. Before the creation of these devices, families would sit together around the table and play games together. But, since the creation of video games, home entertainment has changed to games played by yourself, and the impact of these games on families is very obvious. Today, instead of watching TV together or eating supper together around a table and talking about everyone's day, everyone is in a different room, playing video games, watching TV, texting, or listening to music. The traditional interaction of people has changed.

Think of the days when there were no computers and no modern means of transport. Daily life involved a lot of physical activity. Life of the common man was not as luxurious as that of modern times, but he was more active. Exercise was integrated into routine

physical activities. It was contrary to the lifestyle of today, which leaves no time for exercise and fills days with inactivity and laze. Today we don't want to, and thanks to the advancement in technology, don't even need to walk, move around, or exert ourselves physically to great extents in order to get things done.

Technology today has become a style statement, like owning a BMW. Technology has made us more demanding.

5.2 Technology and Relationship

My research topic is impact of technology on relations, my respondents giving me their personal experiences about their relationships through technology and what are the circumstances the indulgent in the relation and what outcomes they face.

One of my respondent told me that they have face a great social pressure with this and ask that relationship are affected by online communication, It may seem too obvious to mention, but it feels qualitatively different to go out to dinner with friends than to spend several days engaged in back-and-forth email exchanges. So much communication and meaning is lost in the latter. And our effect on one another is much more intense when we meet in person. When a friend is going through a rough time, nothing substitute for in-person communication. A gentle smile or a heartfelt hug has far more power than the cleverest emoticon to lift another person's spirits.

Another respondent shared very useful knowledge with me and I really appreciated that, respondent told me, The Internet is an amazing tool. But even as it's shrunk the world and brought us closer together, it's threatened to push us further apart. Like any useful tool, to make technology serve us well requires the exercise of good judgment. For whatever reason, the. Let's try not to be restraints that stop most of us from blurting out things in public we know we shouldn't seem far weaker when our mode of communication is typing. Unfortunately, typed messages often wound even more gravely, while electronic messages of remorse paradoxically have little power to heal. Perhaps we just don't think such messages have the same power to harm as when we say them in person. Perhaps in the heat of the moment without another's physical presence to hold us back, we just don't care. Whatever the reason, it's clearly far easier for us to be meaner to one another online. Let's try not to be.

One of my respondent shared her personal experience with me which I mentioned here she told me that she was only 16 years old and she was addicted to Facebook once a day she was reading her news feed just by scrolling her mouse, suddenly her friend request portion became red and there was a new friend request of a boy who lived in Multan she checked his profile saw her picture as she made her mind to accept his request so she accepted his friend request and at that time he was online too, chatting started by simply a greeting word and then they talked for hours in the next day at the same time both were online boy asked about her family her personal information she also asked the same questions and this time too they both talked too much without even seeing the time several days passed they had chit chat neglecting about studies and about their families and with the passage of time she talked to him for whole day she forgot that this thing is giving a very bad impression on her studies as well as on her family relations. A time came when she committed a relation with him dreaming about him day and night her studies were badly affected by it she lost her position in her class because she was physically present in class but mentally she was absent her mind was always stuck to that boy one day she was so depressed because she had a fight with him she took it too deeply because he was not talking to her she meant herself so unimportant she did not take her whole day meals and spent her whole day waiting for him to text her but he did not do now she deemed that only Facebook is the main reason which affected her life and her blood relations too she said that yes it is true technology has a great impact on our life it may be good or bad but my personal experience regarding technology was awful.

Another case study which I mentioned here is also about the technology and relationship, my name is Ayesha and I am twenty one years old, I was in a relationship for the last two years I recently had a breakup three months back. Our relationship started online on a social media platform. The relationship started off very intense we would talk for six to seven hours daily, we started off as just friends but gradually developed a liking for each other in a period of six months. We gradually started talking all day and it was an instant attraction, we could not be apart from each other and we would be on our phones the entire so much so that even a break of five minutes or more would upset us. I rarely gave my family or friends any time and so did he and I would be on my phone even if I were out with my friends or my family or doing simple house chores. I preferred him over everyone else. We started calling each other too and that would last for hours at a stretch. I was never this addicted to my phone but because of him I became one. My mother once even mentioned to me that "You are obsessed with this boy". Now that we are no longer together I have free time and it is really difficult for me to

manage it. I believe that if I were not on any social media platforms I would have never met him and that would have been better for me because this attachment really strained my relationship with my mothers and my siblings. And because we were texting all the time it also affected us because then in real life interactions we had nothing to talk about and that would cause problems.

One of my respondents told me that it's an awkward moment and it's a harsh truth that, your relationship with your significant other, your friends and even your boss is completely different now that technology dominates your life you can't enjoy a nice dinner out until someone takes a photo of their meal. Our life is greatly affected by this technology.

These are seven ways that technology is killing our relationship which are as follows

1. We are losing our ability to develop a shared, non-verbal language; we touch less.
2. Sexual imagery and pornography are taking up our mind space, and chipping away at our ability to be satisfied by our significant others.
3. Text, chat, and e-mail is lowering the barriers to communicate with the opposite sex, leading to careless and confusing signals.
4. Technology deprives us of the space we need in a healthy relationship, as we're "accessible" around the clock.
5. Social media is making it easier to keep up with exes "out of curiosity."
6. Technology enhances our perception of "true" options, making it more difficult to take decisive action in relationships.
7. And last but not least, a rather obvious one: technology is eating away at time we could spend connecting with our loved ones.

Technology is excellent for supplementing relationships, but it really should not be used to "replace" any aspect of a relationship. The moment you notice it is replacing a part of your relationship; it is probably time to realize you're starting a competing relationship with your seductive device – putting love in peril.

6 CHANGING OF SOCIAL SETUP

6.1 Technology and Change

One of my respondents noted that as far as in Pakistan adapting new technology was easier when it came to the younger generation while the older generations had a bit more hard time in adapting new or changing technology. He was of the view that one reason is nostalgia that the elders had a sense of attachment to their older belongings and preferred to use them even if they had lesser functions because of their emotional attachments to them. The second

reason was complexity of the technology. Nowadays a single device is supposed to have multiple functions, covering almost everything. So many things crammed into one meant more complexity of the commands and functions hence making it difficult to be accessed or understandable. Another reason according to him was the clash between how much one should assimilate. He had the opinion that a lot of people, even having access to latest technology chose not to adopt it because they felt they would lose their own originality or individuality. That people were in fear of the change it would bring to them

His opinion over how people used technology to adapt to new societal norms or behaviors was that for him people did not adopt the technology as much as it became necessary to do so. Everyone was evolving with opinions, ideas and perceptions and when people found outlets to express them similar sounding individuals started using the same narrative, sometimes modifying it until it became a popular opinion and for everyone to be accepted as 'normal' it became important to choose the same narrative as the popular opinion. He gave an example as: "It's like a group of friends and one mention how good a restaurant is and the others try it out because they want to have an opinion themselves on it and it mostly sides with the first person's opinion because he was a pioneer to it." Overall his view was that it became necessary to use technology to be well aware and to be a part of conversations and thoughts so they could fit in. People have used technology greatly to come with terms with the changes around them since its invention and we still have a long way to go

One of my respondent shares very informative information with me. He told me like that it is fun to dream up, what the future will come in next 2, 3 or even 5 years. What will we eat? How will we trace? What will be our issues? So today I'm going to take you to the world of nexttime.

When it comes to the processing power, human brain just can't be beat. Packed within a squishy football sized organ, there are almost thousands of billions of neurons in a human brain, and each of them can relay its instructions to the thousands of billions of other neurons. The high frequency, the constant ringing, vibrating alerts and reminders can put a cell phone user on risk factor for mental health issues in young adults.

- 4) We are all living longer, and soon we won't be able to look after all of those old people, either financially or in terms of available human labor. Automation of aged care will become critical.

- 6) The person sitting next to us has no time to collaborate with us; He has a machine (cell phone) which can give a better company than any human.

- 7) Automatic water filters have now come to give people some relief. Whenever you need water to drink, they will sense your brain and come by their own to get you water.

- 8) Computers have put millions of people out of work. For example, they have ravaged the book selling business. Book stores are closing all across the World because it is so much more convenient to buy books online and so much easier to find the books you want.

- 9) The automatic system in all over the world has caused health issues as people are losing their activeness and the works they did do by their own potential.

According to Vinod Khosla (Co-founder Microsystems) machines will replace 80% of doctors in a health care future and that will be driven by entrepreneurs, not medical professionals.

In sum, technology widen the options for human activity, e.g. through making things viable that were previously impossible or with the aid of facilitating them. be aware, however, that it is the placement of the author that technology are morally impartial, i.e. there is no according to se announcing that they may be both excellent or awful. This stands in contrast to some faculties of thoughts that see technologies and technological progress as inherently beneficial for humanity.

however, this can additionally work the alternative way spherical. technologies can, via intended or unintentional results, boost new problems that want to be addressed in the political sphere. as an instance, nuclear energy has created political troubles that stay largely unresolved to at the present time, from a way to address nuclear waste to the efforts to curtail
